Each school board shall annually prepare a calendar for the school term specifying the opening and closing dates and providing a min. term of at least 185 days, computed under Section 18-8.05 of the School Code, provided any days allowed by law for teacher institutes but not used as such shall increase the minimum school term by the number of days not so used, however, the board may not extend such term beyond such closing date unless such extension of term is necessary to provide such minimum number of computable days. The board may specify a closing date earlier than that set on the proposed calendar when the schools of the district have provided the minimum number of computable days required.

District or staff may submit their calendars electronically to ISBE, via the ROE on a "floppy" disk or through email. All others should submit two originals of Form 33-03 through the appropriate ROE by JUNE 1, 2002. That office will forward one original to the F & D Div. of ISBE by June 15, 2002. FINAL CALENDARS ARE TO BE FORWARDED TO THE ROE NO LATER THAN THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL.
