

Board Briefs
August 10, 2010

The Board of Education conducted the following business at its regular monthly meeting last night:

1. Reviewed and approved the Treasurer's report. The State is still significantly behind on the payments to the district.
2. Received the annual report from the FFA. This report highlighted the activities and accomplishments of the organization over the past year.
3. Approved the overnight trip requests of the FFA and FCCLA for the 2010-2011 school year.
4. Approved the tuition request from an out of district resident.
5. Reviewed and approved the FY 2011 tentative budget. Governor Quinn signed the budget into law this past Tuesday so we are still trying to identify all of its components. There will be some changes to the tentative budget over the next month. The tentative budget is officially on display as required by law. The budget hearing is scheduled for September 13, 2010 at 7:00.
6. Scheduled a special Board meeting for September 1, 2010 at 6:00 for interviewing potential Board member candidates. The Board also rescheduled the March 2011 Board meeting to March 7, 2011 in order to avoid conflicts with spring break.
7. Accepted the resignation from Tony Klein from his assistant football coaching position.
8. Hired Ed Hurst as an assistant football coach.
9. Hired Josie Luedke as HS Student Council Sponsor.
10. Hired Diane Edwards as a special education Bus Aide.
